

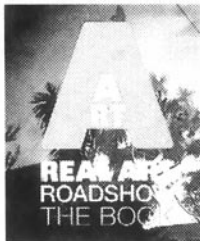
THE BOOK of the art of the roadshow that restores your faith in humanity.

Briefly: local philanthropist buys up contemporary art in a big way, packs it into trailers, tours 70 schools the length of the country and calls it **The Real Art Roadshow**: saving the world one art student at a time.

Start with Albrecht and finish with Youle. Everyone went along for the ride. And now the collection is going off-road. Buy the hardback book and you get stunning full-page reproductions of 126 works and the accompanying essays and study links – websites, YouTube search words and reference books.

Written for secondary school students, the essays are genuinely accessible. And if they're not, there's a handy glossary of art words. Ex voto? A religious painting commissioned out of thanks for delivery from a dangerous or bad situation.

What kind of conversations did the Real Art Roadshow create? One Auckland student said: "It was really inspiring and really confusing at the same time". And another, from Kawerau: "Art is so cool and astonishing." Just like the Real Art Roadshow, really.
